MRC91 OPEN TOPIC DISCUSSION NET SCRIPT 7 pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday night

Good evening! On behalf of the MRC91 repeater, I would like to welcome you to tonight's Open Topic Discussion Net. My name is (*Your Name and Call*), and I am located in (*Your Location*) and I will be your net control operator for tonight's net. Licensed Amateurs, Technician class or higher are encouraged to check in either with or without traffic.

Before we start tonight's net, if you should have an emergency during this net, please let us know and we will stop to handle your emergency.

This is an open topic net and as such we will first take check-ins after which we will call on each person in order for them to either suggest a discussion topic or to simply discuss what is new with them or anything else they wish to share with the group. If for some reason you do not wish to participate in the traffic portion of the net simple state "No Traffic" when checking in but we hope that you will chose to participate.

Lets get started, check ins are in alphabetical segments, based on the first letter following the numeral in your call sign. Mobile stations may ignore the roll call segments and check in at any time it is safe to do so. During check ins, please respond with your call sign SLOWLY in standard phonetics along your first name please. If you miss your check-in segment feel free to check-in at anytime.

Again, this is (Your Name and Call) your net control operator this evening.

We will now begin check ins with any mobile stations: Mobile stations come now please.

(Acknowledge by repeating what you heard and logged)

We will now take check-ins from the alphabetical segment:

(Call sign segment suggestions)

A-ALPHA thru F-FOXTROT G-Golf thru K-KILO L-LIMA thru P=PAPA Q-QUEBEC thru V-VICTOR W-WHISKEY thru Z-ZULU

"A -Alpha thru F-Foxtrot come now please" (and so on)

(Miscellaneous Notes for the Net Control Operator)

(Before you first start the traffic portion of the net do a final call for check-ins of the entire alphabet A-Alpha thru Z-Zulu and then proceed to the traffic)

(If someone suggests a topic feel free to run with it as you see fit. You are the net control so the choice falls on you. Try to keep the discussion going but don't feel you need to stretch the net out. Naturally you should avoid any topic that may be controversial such as religion or politics, use your best judgment)

(As net control operator it is suggested that as a minimum you offer each person who checks-in one opportunity to speak (if they so desire) and then after all people have had that opportunity start a "73" round at a minimum. If the discussion (or topic) is going well feel free to go a second round. Again the net traffic will dictate how long it wants to run)

(Please remember to use your call sign at least every 10 minutes per FCC regulations. Also, ask your guests to repeat their call sign if you read it back incorrectly)

(Please take all check ins prior to the traffic portion of the net)

(At the end of the net ask for any late check-ins and then ask if there is any final business)

Are there any late check-ins or any final business for tonight's net? Come now please.

(If there are any handle as needed)

(If there are none say)

Hearing none, this net is now secure at ____PM. Thank you all for participating and a reminder that this net along with most of the other nets here on the MRC91 repeater welcome new operators to experience net control operation by trying a net or two. If you wish to try acting as a net control operator please contact our club president Karen, KC9WQJ to participate. All net scripts are on the club web site for your review.

At this time we will now return the repeater to normal amateur use.
